

Rail Trade Mission to Ireland 25-26th January, Dublin

UK railway suppliers are invited to apply to join a Department for Business and Trade (DBT) and Railway Industry Association (RIA) rail trade mission to Ireland.

The programme will include 1:1 meetings with officials from the National Transport Authority, Transport Infrastructure Ireland and Irish Rail, and a site visit may be included in the programme.

Information provided in the application process will be shared with the clients, who will in turn select companies to take part in the mission based on this information. This in turn may mean that UK Suppliers are offered 1 or more appointments or not preselected.

Costs, Travel:

- Do not commit to flights until appointments are confirmed.
- Limited to 2 delegates per company limit, 2nd delegate is at no cost.
- Mission delegates will need to cover their own travel and subsistence costs to Dublin.
- Participation in the trade mission will cost £250 + VAT. Payment will be invoiced once appointments are confirmed.

Registration and Eligibility:

- The event is open to all UK registered companies, a maximum of 2 delegates per company
- Registration does not confirm participation. We will aim to confirm places before the end of December.
