


# Social Post Templates 'How to Guide'

The following guide will walk you though how to create image & video posts for your socials using our pre-built templates. All you will need is a version of Microsoft Powerpoint

# STEP ONE - Choose which size post best suits your needs.

There are two base Powerpoint files. One to create square posts at 1080x 1080px & one to create landscape posts at 1200 x 628px. Use whichever is best suited for your planned post. or chosen social media platform.



# STEP TWO - Choose your layout.

Each file comes with a variety of pre-built layouts. The layouts in each file are summarised below.


# STEP THREE - Change your Image / Place video

- Select the place-holder image.
- · Click on the PICTURE FORMAT tab
- Select CHANGE PICTURE, and choose your new image file



Note: If a video is required this will need to be placed manually as Powerpoint currently does not include the option to replace video links. To insert a video

- · Click on the INSERT tab
- · Select VIDEO, and choose your new video file
- · Scale & position the video preview



# STEP FOUR- Change your text (If applicable)

Any text boxes are fully editable.

There is currently a place holder for a title & body text. Simple click and type.



# STEP FIVE- Delete all non required slides

Before exporting please delete any unwanted slides

# STEP SIX- Export your file

When your design is ready, click on the FILE tab / EXPORT

For Images: CHANGE FILE TYPE / Image file types / PNG or JPEG / Save As

For Videos: CREATE VIDEO / Standard (480p) / Create video
